

Non-Degree application for Masters:

The Department does offer Non-Degree registration. You can take up to 18 credits before acceptance to the Masters COE program at FAU. Only 6 credits from another University can apply (must be less than 7 years old). If applicable, this would correct the credits accepted from FAU to 12 before acceptance.

So, you can still start now, upon acceptance you can apply your credits to the program.

To start:

- 1) You would need to register as a Non-degree seeking student first, if no already a student in FAU. Click on the following link for the required paperwork:

- 2) Only after Non-degree registration period begins, you would come to the Department for a faculty signature or email the instructor of record for the course. This would be to reserve your seat in the classroom (this procedure is required for any and all courses in the program).
