A completed application consists of the following items:

To the Department of Counselor Education:

- ◆ Written personal goal statement
- ◆ Three letters of recommendation attesting to your suitability for graduate study and entry into the field of professional counseling; on reference's letterhead.
- ◆ Separate work experience. Resume and/or essay describing any prior work including volunteering experience related to counseling.

To FAU Graduate Admissions Office:

- ◆ A completed FAU Graduate Application and fee
- ◆ Official copies of all undergraduate and graduate transcripts
- ◆ Official GRE Exam score (verbal, quantitative, (and writing for Ph.D. only) taken within the past five years
 - GRE 1000/GPA 2.5 or GRE 800/GPA 3.0
