The College of Education at Florida Atlantic University is seeking applications for the position of Charles Stewart Mott Professor, an Eminent Scholar's Chair in Community Education. The successful applicant must be capable of providing visionary leadership for Community Education at the local, state, national, and international levels. This Chair is funded by endowments from the C.S. Mott Foundation, the U.S Sugar Charitable Trust, Marjorie Pearson, and matching funds from the State of Florida. This Eminent Scholar's position has been in the College of Education since 1985.

Florida Atlantic University, a member of the State University System of Florida is a Research University (high research activity) newly classified by Carnegie Foundation, and is a rapidly growing institution with a current enrollment in excess of 25,000 students. FAU's primary service area includes the counties of Palm Beach, Broward, Martin, St. Lucie, Indian River, and Okeechobee. This position will be at Boca Raton Campus.

The individual selected must possess an earned doctorate in community education or in a related field and must have the qualifications in teaching, research and service for appointment at the rank of full professor. In addition, the successful candidate should possess an exemplary recent record of teaching, research and scholarship in Community Education and/or related fields. A highly successful track record of procuring grants for research and scholarly activities is expected. Successful candidate is expected to be involved in ongoing fundraising efforts to increase private philanthropic support with special but not exclusive emphasis on the endowment that supports the chair. Compensation includes a competitive nine-month salary, secretarial support, travel funds and other resources including possible research collaborations with the Melby doctoral fellow.
